1.INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE CENTER

At Shobi College of Music, students gather from all over the world such as Asia, Europe and America. The International Exchange Center was established with the aim of supporting all our international students. We provide consultation and assistance on all your concerns related to learning, visa applications, scholarships etc.

♦ SUPPORT DURING ENTRANCE APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Support is available in English, Chinese, Korean and Japanese. We provide support based on your standpoint regarding career decisions.

♦ VISA SUPPORT

Shobi is recognized by the Immigration Bureau as a proper school. In general, international students are granted a student visa valid for 2 years or 4 years. Assistance in student visa applications is provided.

♦DAILY LIFE SUPPORT

We provide all-round support to help you get adjusted to life in Japan including assistance with any problems you may encounter when living in Japan, such as providing hospital and clinic information in times of emergency.

♦ SHOBI SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

While in school, international students are eligible to apply for scholarships of a maximum of 300,000 yen in total upon entrance into SHOBI. There are also other scholarships available like Honor Student Entrance Scholarship and Advancement Scholarship.

◆ AFFILIATED DORMITORIES

We can introduce you to affiliated dormitories with special rates for international students. This furnished dormitory rates start from 55,000 yen per month (2 meals per day included).



4.ADMISSION INFORMATION • NOTICE OF RESULTS • ENTRANCE PROCEDURES

- ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must fulfill at least one of the four following conditions:
 - ① Applicants must have completed 12 years of education or be expected to graduate by March 2024.
 - ② Applicants must hold a certificate equivalent to the "Certificate for Students Achieving the Proficiency Level of Upper Secondary School Graduates" or expect to receive it by the end of March 2024 and be at least 18 years old as of April 1, 2024.
 - ③ If the period regarding the statements above (①and ②) is less than 12 years, the applicant must
 - (4) have finished the preparatory course as issued by the Japanese Minister of Education or expect to receive it by the end of March 2024 and be at least 18 years old as of April 1, 2024.
 - ⑤ Applicant must be certified as a high school graduate equivalent as issued by SHOBI and at least 18 years old as of April 1, 2024.

■ ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must fulfill all of the following conditions:

- ① The applicant must fulfill the admission requirements, pass the entrance examinations and complete all required entrance procedures before the given deadline.
- ② The applicant must demonstrate a fluency in the Japanese language that is sufficient for studying at SHOBI in one of following ways:
 - A. Certificate of Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N1 or N2.
 - B. Score 200 or above on the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) Japanese as a foreign language subject component.
 - C. Score 400 or above on the BJT Business Japanese Proficiency Test.
 - D. Proof of attendance at a Japanese language school (limited to the courses predetermined by the Minister of Justice) and receiving Japanese education for not less than 6 months and pass SHOBI's Japanese language examination equivalent to JLPT N2.
 - E. Proof of attendance at a school (other than kindergarten) as approved by the first condition of the School Education Act of Japan for a period of not less than one year and pass SHOBI's Japanese language examination.
- ③ The applicant must have sufficient funds for expenses during the entire period of study, including living costs.

However, applicants who have passed the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N1 or N2, scored 200 points or more on the Japanese language section of the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU), or 400 points or more on the BJT Business Japanese Proficiency Test and provided the relevant documents are exempt from the SHOBI's Japanese language examination.

2) 'Living with Music' Entrance Scholarship

Students who are determined to go to SHOBI, start preparing at an early stage and enters SHOBI through the AO Admission Application are eligible to receive this scholarship which is not required to return. Everyone's continuous effort and the desire to acquire the specialized knowledge and skills necessary for the jobs they are aiming for in the future will also have a positive impact on their learning after entering SHOBI. At the same time, we believe that it always leads to good results. This scholarship is awarded to prospective students with strong will to ease the economic burden of tuition fees.
