1. INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE CENTER

We provide consultation and assistance with all your concerns related to learning, visa applications, scholarships etc.

♦ SUPPORT DURING ENTRANCE PROCEDURE

We support international students in English, Chinese, Korean and Japanese.

♦ VISA SUPPORT

SHOBI is recognized by the Immigration Bureau as a proper school. In general, it is possible for international students to apply a student visa valid for 2 years or 4 years. We also provide support for application for extension of period of stay.

We provide all-round support to help you get used to life in Japan including assistance with any problems you may encounter when living in Japan such as providing information of medical institutions in times of emergency.

♦ SHOBI ORIGINAL SCHOLARSHIPS

International students are eligible to apply for scholarships of up to 200,000 yen while enrolled in SHOBI. Other scholarships such as Honor Student Entrance Scholarship and scholarship when move on to the next grade are also available.



4. ADMISSION INFORMATION • NOTICE OF RESULTS • ENTRANCE PROCEDURE

■ ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION: Applicants who meet one or more of the following criteria:

- ① Those who have finished 12 years of education or are expected to graduate by March 2025.
- ② Those who have a certificate equivalent to the "Certificate for Students Achieving the Proficiency Level of Upper Secondary School Graduates" or expect to receive it by the end of March 2025 as well as aged 18 and up as of April 1, 2025.
- ③ If the period regarding the statements above (①and ②) is less than 12 years, the applicant must have finished the preparatory course as issued by the MEXT or expect to receive it by the end of March 2025 as well as aged 18 and up as of April 1, 2025.
- 4 Those who are certified as a high school graduate equivalent as issued by SHOBI as well as aged 18 and up as of April 1, 2025.

■ ELIGIBILITY FOR ENTRANCE: Applicants who meet all of the following criteria:

- ① Those who meet the eligibility for admission, pass the entrance examinations and complete all required entrance procedures before the given deadline.
- ② Those who can demonstrate the proficiency in Japanese which is sufficient for studying at SHOBI in one of following ways:
 - A. Certificate of Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N1 or N2.
 - B. Score 200 or above (except writing section) on the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) Japanese as a foreign language subject component.
 - C. Score 400 or above on the BJT Business Japanese Proficiency Test.
 - D. Proof of attendance at a Japanese language school (limited to the courses predetermined by the Minister of Justice) and receiving Japanese education for not less than 6 months and pass SHOBI's Japanese language examination equivalent to JLPT N2.
 - E. Proof of attendance at a school (other than kindergarten) as approved by the first condition of the School Education Act of Japan for a period of not less than one year and pass SHOBI's Japanese language examination.
- ③ Those who have sufficient funds for expenses during the entire period of study, including living costs in Japan.

■ MISCELLANEOUS FEES

- Student Accident Insurance: Please pay the insurance fee when entrance procedure. 2-Year Departments: 1,610 yen 4-Year Department: 2,970 yen (Fees for 2023)
- Teaching Materials Fee:

Students are required to buy textbooks and teaching materials related to department/major/course every year.

- Supporters Association fee:
 Enrollment fee: 20 000 yen (only for the 1)
 - Enrollment fee: 20,000 yen (only for the 1st year). Annual fee: 30,000 yen (from the 1st year to the 4th year).
- Alumni Association Fee: 50,000 yen (only for the graduation year).
- A portion of the Public Performance Fee: Students may be required to cover part of the performance costs.
- Graduation Fee: Please pay the graduation event fee for the graduation year (Fees for 2023: 28,000 yen).

6. SCHOLARSHIPS

1) *International Students Entrance Scholarship

Those who applied SHOBI as an international student can receive a **50%** exemption from their entrance fee during the entrance procedure. To apply for this scholarship, applicants should submit the 'Application for International Students' form on P.11-12 of the <2025 Application Forms for International Students> alongside the general application form.
